JOB DESCRIPTION

He/She is to make disciples of students, raise up leaders and plan engaging events that will be relevant for the next gen. He/She will work alongside the staff to carry out the mission of OKC Faith Church.

JOB DESCRIPTION LIST

1. Provide overall leadership to our Youth Ministry. Providing a ministry that engages, impacts and builds up this generation.
2. Model and raise the value of a Christ-centered lifestyle within the youth and young adults of our church.
3. Build a growing Youth Ministry team to effectively reach and disciple the Youth of OKC Faith Church. This team will be essential to the effectiveness of this ministry.
4. Maintain a close working relationship with the public and private schools of our community. Make

connections with students from our schools, drawing them into the fellowship of our church and into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

5. Collaborate with the church's staff as we work with unity to fulfill the vision and mission of OKC Faith.

6. Make and maintain positive relationships with leaders of the community, especially those leaders of our schools and other organizations.

7. Establish strong relationships with the youth of OKC Faith Church, maximizing ministry impact in their lives.

8. Provide counseling and spiritual direction to Youth on an individual basis.

9. Maintain contact with students and parents, keeping them informed of ongoing activities. Keep parents updated on ministry strategies and plans in a way that encourages partnership and involvement.

10. Manage student fees and fundraising for events and ministry mission trips.

11. Participate in weekly staff meetings and one-on-one meetings with the Senior Pastor.

12. Plan and prepare all services, meetings, and activities that will reach and impact this generation in an effective way.

13. Attend/Lead a week of church camp and potentially a Mission Trip every year.

8. Exemplify obedience to the Word of God and

devotion to a deep-rooted prayer life.

9. Must have a clear testimony to a saving, sanctifying and growing relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

10. Model a Christ-like lifestyle and a passion to reach the lost for Jesus Christ.
